

Kerry surpasses 2020 Environmental Targets



In 2018, Kerry's strong environmental performance has resulted in the Group exceeding its 2020 goals for emissions and waste reduction, a year ahead of target.

With the release of the 2018 Sustainability review, Kerry has outlined that reductions in carbon and waste intensity have already surpassed its 2020 ambition. By year end, carbon intensity had fallen by 16.4% versus a 2013 base year, while waste is down 22.7% versus the same period.

In addition, Kerry delivered a 6.6% improvement in water efficiency and remains on track to meet its 2020 target. The Group is also aiming to be a zero waste to landfill business by 2020 and by the end of 2018, was already diverting 90% of waste from landfill.

Alongside these environmental achievements, the 2018 sustainability review also sets out the significant progress made by the Group's across all four pillars of the 'Towards 2020' programme.
