

Project Leche Announced as Finalist in World Dairy Innovation Awards 2019



Kerry’s Project Leche, as a private sector partner of the World Food Programme, is a finalist in the “Best sustainability/CSR initiative” category at The World Dairy Innovation awards.

These global awards in association with the 13th Global Dairy Congress, are a celebration of innovation and excellence across every category of the international dairy industry. The awards take place in Lisbon, Portugal on 26 June.

Project Leche is a unique CSR initiative launched by Kerry and the World Food Programme (WFP) in Honduras in 2016. Under the project, Kerry contributes financially to WFP’s school meals project, but more importantly shares its expert knowledge in nutrition and sustainable dairy production. Through locally sourced dairy from smallholder farmers, Kerry and WFP have enhanced the nutritional content of school meals as well as establishing a scalable and replicable model for sustainable development that delivers value for the entire community.

Kerry’s contribution to Project Leche has positively impacted the health and socioeconomic situation of local communities in the dry corridor of Choluteca in Honduras.
